Siyabonga! Re a leboga! Daie Dankie! Thank you for your dedication towards conserving our fauna and flora for posterity!*
- 12. You continue to be the last line of defense for wildlife; you stand between survival and extinction of our endangered species, as you face dangerous, cruel and selfish criminals.
- 13. Our fauna and flora are definitely safe in your caring hands. Our tourism industry will continue to boom because of your selfless dedication. We honour and celebrate you!
