## PREMIER NDLOVU TO PAY COURTESY VISITS TO THE TRADITIONAL LEADERSHIP OF THE NDEBELE NATION

The Mpumalanga Premier, Mr. Mandla Ndlovu is determined to strengthen the working relations between the Provincial Government and the traditional leadership.
